Certificate III in Swimming Pool and Spa Service

Qualification Overview

The CPP31218 Certificate III in Swimming Pool and Spa Service equips students with the skills and knowledge needed to work as a swimming pool and spa technician.

Student Co-contribution Fees

- **Standard fee:** \$1,998, payable at enrolment.
- **Concessional fee:** \$1,800, payable at enrolment.

Students may be eligible for the concessional fee if they:

- Hold a Health Care Card, Veteran Card or Pensioner Concession Card (or are the partner or dependent named on the card).
- Identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander (First Nations).
- Have a disability.
- Are an adult prisoner.

Fees cover all training and materials. Fees cannot be waived or paid by the training provider.

Delivery and Duration

- Delivered fully online through our learning platform.
- Flexible study timelines, typically completed over 12 to 18 months depending on progress, with up to two years allowed for completion.
- Assessment methods include online theory tasks, practical evidence, and workplace activities where applicable.

Requirements for Completion

- Completion of all units of competency.
- Submission of required workplace evidence to demonstrate practical skills.

Student Support

- Access to trainers and assessors for individual support throughout your studies.
- Additional assistance may be available on request.
